

## SUMMER SCHOOL ACCOMMODATION

To make your stay in London more convenient and economical we offer an accommodation service for Central Saint Martins Summer School students. During the summer many of the University Halls of Residences surrounding the college open their rooms for individual bookings. By booking at one of these Halls it will give you the chance to meet people attending similar courses at the Summer School or those simply visiting London for a vacation. The Halls have been chosen for their location, easy transport to Central Saint Martins, excellent facilities and services, security and value for money. All prices are quoted for bed and (in most cases) breakfast only, although twin rooms and evening meals may be arranged at some halls. If you wish to book complete the accommodation booking form and return this with your course enrolment and payment details. You should try to book early as this economical alternative to a hotel is always popular, so places may be limited, particularly in the peak month of July. You must also read the booking conditions (on the next page) before booking. See map on page 65 for the accommodation locations in relation to the college sites.

### Passfield Hall, London WC1



Passfield Hall reopened in 2006 following an extensive year-long refurbishment. It now boasts modern facilities within one of the finest examples of Georgian architecture in an area of London notable for its Georgian buildings.

The hall is made up of three buildings surrounding a walled garden which lends an air of serenity within the hustle and bustle of central London. The hall is ideally located for the West End, Covent Garden and Oxford Street with the British Library and British Museum in close walking distance.

Passfield offers single, twin and triple rooms all with shared bathroom facilities and all rooms are sold on a bed and breakfast basis with breakfast served in the dining hall overlooking the garden. A small number of wheelchair accessible single rooms are available upon request. Bedrooms are serviced daily and the hall provides a coin-operated laundry, two TV rooms and a bar area.

### Connaught Hall, London WC1



A converted terrace of Georgian houses, Connaught Hall lies at the heart of historic Bloomsbury, within 10 minutes' walk from Central Saint Martins' main Southampton Row building. It is also within walking distance of the British Museum, Oxford Street, Covent Garden and Leicester Square. All rooms have washbasins, tea/coffee making facilities, and a telephone. There are shared bathrooms on each floor, plus a laundry, TV room and private garden – ideal for the summer. Please note – unaccompanied students must be at least 18 years of age to stay in this hall.

Single Room £36. This rate includes VAT and Breakfast

### Alexander Fleming Halls of Residence, London EC1



Situated on the edge of the 'City', the most historic part of London, home to the financial district and to St Paul's Cathedral, Hoxton is also becoming important as an up-and-coming arts centre, with the Lux Cinema, Comedy Cafe and Circus Space only a few minutes' walk away. It is close to the traditional East End markets and has excellent transport links by bus, tube and train.

The accommodation consists of single study bedrooms arranged in self-contained units of four, six or eight. Each unit has private bathrooms, a large kitchen/diner with fridge-freezer, oven, microwave, kettle and toaster, and its own TV. The halls each have coin and card operated phones, wireless internet access, laundry facilities and 24 hour access and security. These are self-catering halls.

Single Room £30. This rate includes VAT

### Nufford House, London W1



This accommodation is situated a few minutes' walk from Oxford Street, the famous shopping area of central London. Close to Marble Arch Underground Station that can take you to any of the college sites, this is an excellent location for those wishing to sample Regent Street, Bond Street, Piccadilly Circus and Buckingham Palace. There is also a large leisure centre nearby.

Each room has a telephone and wash basin with shared bathroom facilities on every floor. There are two TV lounges, a common room, laundry and private garden area. Please note – unaccompanied students must be at least 18 years of age to stay in this hall. This is a non-smoking hall.

Single Room £34; Twin Room £53.

## Carr-Saunders Hall, London W1

Carr-Saunders is ideally located just off Tottenham Court Road, only a short walk to most of the Central Saint Martins sites and London's famous shopping and theatre districts.

Facilities at Carr-Saunders are very clean, with comfortable bedrooms which are serviced daily. The rooms all have a desk, washbasin and a card operated telephone. There is also a large common area with cable TV and games equipment, an inexpensive coin-op laundry, and kitchens on each floor. The Hall is very secure with key cards, air-lock entrances, security staff over night and CCTV. A full English or continental breakfast is served on the top floor with stunning views over London. The Hall is non-smoking. Please note – unaccompanied students must be at least 18 years of age to stay in this hall.

Single £37; Twin £58;

## Rosebery Hall, Clerkenwell, London EC1



Rosebery Hall is located in the fashionable Clerkenwell district of London. Nearby are Sadler's Wells Theatre, Camden Passage (one of London's premier antique centres) and a wide range of interesting shops, bars and lively street markets. Rosebery Hall is also a short walk away from Central Saint Martin's Southampton Row and Back Hill sites.

Facilities at Rosebery Hall are very clean, with comfortable bedrooms which are serviced daily. A full English breakfast and continental buffet are available to all guests. There is also 24 hour security, a modern bar area, an inexpensive laundry with ironing facilities, and fully equipped kitchens if you wish to cater for yourself. There is a TV room with satellite link and direct dial telephones in all rooms.

Single Standard Bedrooms £35 per room per night; Twin Bedrooms £55 per room per night; Twin En-suite Bedroom £76 per room per night. These rates include VAT and breakfast.

## ACCOMMODATION BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1 London Artscom Ltd is acting as a booking agent only and cannot be held liable for any defects in, or complaints about, accommodation provided. These must be taken up with the management of the hall of residence concerned.
- 2 To ensure that a room can be reserved, payment processed and confirmation sent to you it is recommended that you book at least five days before you intend to stay.
- 3 If you wish to cancel your accommodation more than one month before the booking commences you will receive a 50% refund of your paid accommodation charges. The balance will only be repayable if London Artscom Ltd is able to sell your accommodation to another student. All reasonable efforts will be made to do this and in this case you will receive a refund of the remaining 50% less a £30 administrative charge.
- 4 If it is less than one month before the booking commences no refund will be possible and you will forfeit all accommodation charges paid.
- 5 If you wish to deduct days from your booking once it has been confirmed there will be a £30 administrative charge (All changes must be received at least 30 days before your booking is due to commence).
- 6 All requests for cancellations must be received in writing.
- 7 In the event of Central Saint Martins cancelling your course and no replacement course being found, you can request to cancel your accommodation booking for the period that the course would have spanned. However, any other accommodation bookings for other short courses still stand and will not be refunded.
- 8 These booking conditions are independent of those stated for your short course booking. Each hall of residence has rules for the behaviour of guests. You will be given a copy of these when you check in to the hall.

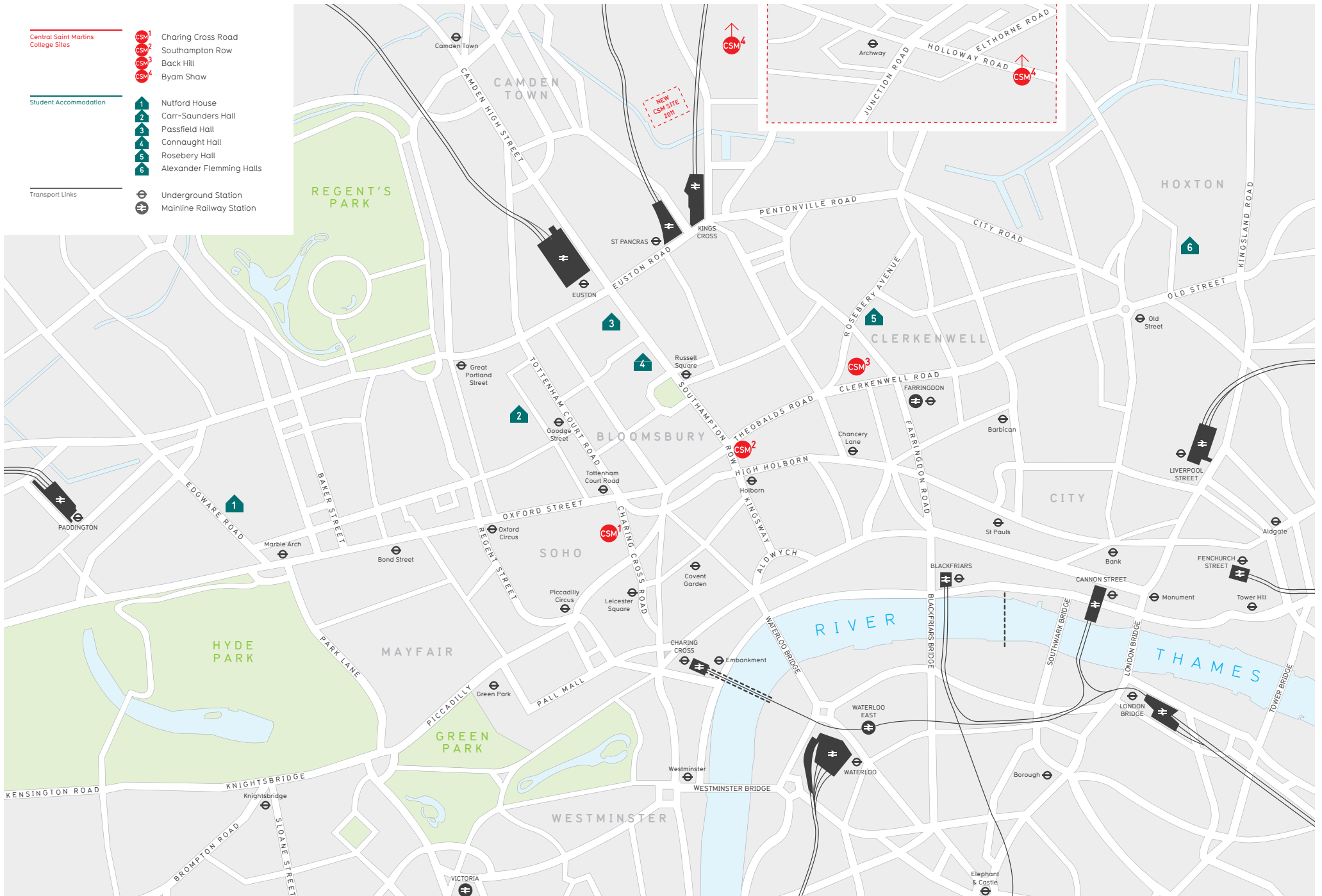
